# About Us Operating Department Nagpur Division Central Railway

The Operating department is headed by Sr. Divisional Operations Manager and at Headquarter level by Chief Operations Manager, Mumbai. The Division comprises of 993.12 route kilometers and 94 Block stations. The division is a major crossing link in North-South and East-West corridors.

# **Freight loading**

- The division has loaded **44.39 million tons in 2022-23** which is more than 54% of Central Railway's total originating loading. In 2023-24 in Apr-Aug period 20.29 million tons has been loaded against 17.53 million tons in the same period last year, a rise of 15.7% over last year. This is highest ever loading in Apr-Aug period.
- Coal which comprises of 90% of total loading by the division is loaded by WCL for powerhouses, non-core and private consumers. Private coal loading is also done from CKNI for Sunflag industries, Bhandara and washed coal from PVIT, MKCW sidings, Rajur & Wani goods shed.
- Cement and Clinker is loaded from ACC Cement siding located at Ghuggus & RGTM siding at Mukutban.
- Container from PCPK siding Khapri, DLIB siding Borkhedi and MLSW / Wardha.
- Other commodities are De-oiled cake, Foodgrain, Military, Iron & Steel, Tractors, Cotton seed husk, Fly ash, Dolomite, Molasses, sugar, ferro-manganese etc.
- Unloading of coal takes place at two major state-owned power houses at Chandrapur and Sarni and also at Private power houses of PWCL at Warora, PMEC at CKNI and MDIT at Tadali and VIPS at Sindi.
- POL is unloaded at Khapri, Borkhedi, Nayara siding, Dahegaon and Tadali.
- Foodgrain is unloaded at FCI sidings at Ajni and Sewagram.

### Interchange


- On an average 146 M/Exp and passenger trains run per day in the division. Four pairs of Rajdhani, two pairs Garib-rath and six pairs of Duronto and one pair of Vande Bharat trains traverse the division. Primary maintenance of 11 pairs of M/exp. and 8 pairs of passenger rakes are done on the division.
- There are nine interchange points with adjacent Railways/Divisions. Jujharpur with West Central Rly, Nagpur, Godhani chord cabin, Chhindwara&Chanda fort with South East Central Railway, Ballarshah and Pimpalkuti with South Central Rly, Badneraand Chandur Bazar with Bhusawal Division.

On an average 225 freight trains are interchanged per day.

#### **Ghat section**

Movement of trains in Nagpur-Itarsi-Nagpur section is a daunting task as two major steep Ghat sections are located in this section. The Teegaon – Chichonda section has a ruling gradient of 1 in 70 while in Dharakoh-Maramjhiri section there is a ruling gradient of 1 in 60. Banker engines have to be provided to push the trains up the Ghat whereas Assisting Engine is provided while descending down the Ghat.

# NGP division's Freight Performance - Dec-23



- Total originating loading of 35.25 million tons was achieved upto Dec-23 against 30.90 million tons last year, a growth of 14.1% (+4.35 MT) over the last year. This is best ever in Apr-Dec period.
- Total freight earnings of Rs. 3786.01 cr. achieved against Rs. 3216.41 cr. last year a growth of 17.7% (+Rs. 569.60 cr.) over last year. This is also best ever in Apr-Dec period.
- 7142 rakes of Coal against 6456 rakes last year (+10.6%).
- 498 rakes of Iron ore against 388 rakes last year (+28.4%).
- 75 rakes of Iron and steel against 50 rakes last year (+50%).
- 466 rakes of cement against 229 rakes last year (+103.5%).
- 163 rakes of clinker against 118 rakes last year (+38.1%).
- 941 rakes of containers against 907 rakes last year (+3.7%)
- 70 rakes of De-oiled cake against 49 rakes last year (+42.9%)
- 8 rakes of tractors against 3 rakes last year (+166.7%)
- Overall **lead** improved by **2.8%** from 494 last year to **508** in the current year.
- NTKMs (millions) increased by 17.3% from 15268 NTKMs last year to 17908 NTKMs in the current year.
- Total **2672 crack trains** (9.7 per day) were also run during the year.
