Applications / options are invited from eligible staff of Central Railway for selection to the one
'ex-cadre' post of Chief Enquiry Inspector in Matrix Level-7 (7th PC), PB-2,GP-Rs.4600 (6th PC),
on tenure basis, for working in Vigilance deptt. of Central Railway, CSMT, Mumbai.

The normal period of tenure of the post is 3 (Three) years, which could be extended for further
period upto 2(Two) years, if so required by the department. On completion of the tenure, the
staff would be repatriated to the respective parent cadre on the Railway, where he/she holds
lien. However, the staff selected for the post could be repatriated at any time, on or before
completion of the tenure without assigning any reason whatsoever.

Selection Process:-

In terms of Indian Railway Vigilance Manual (IRVM)-2018, Chapter-VIII, Para.821.5 the normal
establishment rules applicable to regular selection posts need not to be applied in the case of
this selection.

A written examination and a Vigilance Aptitude and computer knowledge test will be conducted
as part of selection procedure. The distribution of marks for selection is as following:-

Written Examination:-

The written test will include questions on knowledge about Railway working, writing of report, knowledge about Railway services (Conduct) Rules, DAR Rules & Regulations, inquiries, Railway Establishment rules & regulations, process, Manuals, working / functioning etc. No supplementary examination will be taken.

The eligibility criteria and conditions are as follows:

- 1) Supervisory/ Ministerial staff of all departments having completed seven years service (on the date of issuing this notification) and working in substantive Level-7 (7th PC) and one level below on regular basis (Not under MACP).
- 2) The staff should have sound integrity and should not be figuring in any current DAR / SPE / Vigilance case and should not have been imposed any minor/major penalty in any past Vigilance case. Past record of vigilance case would debar candidate from the selection.

General Conditions

1. Applications must be forwarded through proper channel.
2. Application should be made as per proforma enclosed and must be filled and signed by the candidate himself/herself giving the correct information best to his/her knowledge, especially regarding SPE/Vigilance/DAR cases. No alterations/correction on the application will be entertained. Applicants must note that if any information furnished by him/her are found to be false at any stage, the application/candidature will be summarily rejected. Submission of false or misleading information by applicant will lead to DAR action.
3. The particulars as submitted by the applicant in his/her application must be verified and signed by the concerned Supervisor, clearly mentioning own name & designation and office. While verifying the application, any additional information /alteration / correction, remarks made must be signed with date, name and designation of the verifying personnel. For correctness of the information concerned office will be solely responsible and no way vigilance deptt. will have any responsibility in this regard.
4. Forwarded application must have signature, stamp and office seal of the competent authority.
5. The selected candidate will be posted in HQ at CSMT, Mumbai and for allotment of accommodation he/she should have to take their regular turn as per rule.
6. The staff should have good reputation and possess good writing ability.
7. The staff should have interest and physical fitness for the same.
8. The staff should possess sufficient knowledge of Railway Service (Conduct) Rules and Railway Servants (Discipline and Appeal) Rules and other codes.
9. Preference will be given to the employees who are having working knowledge of computer.


10. The applicants may be specifically advised that the post of Chief Enquiry Inspector is a tenure post for three years, but the Vigilance organization reserves the right to repatriate him even earlier without assigning any reason.
11. Sufficient number of SC/ST employees may be considered while sending the recommendations for recruitment of Chief Enquiry Inspector.
12. The selected candidates may be repatriated to his parent department if it becomes necessary for the administration without assigning any reason, or if he/she gets selected for any higher grade post.
13. Those who have already completed their tenure as CEI in Vigilance branch should not apply.
14. Attested Zerox copies of APARs for the year ending on 2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22 & 2022-23 of the candidates may please be sent to this office along with the application forms.
15. No direct applications will be entertained in this office.
16. The candidates whose names have been recommended should be relieved immediately in the event of his selection as CEI.
17. Once selected, applicants will not be permitted to withdraw and refuse posting in vigilance department.
18. The confirmed date of written test will be intimated to eligible candidates later.
19. It may be noted that, mere being called for appearing in the written test or appearing in the written test, no way confirms the applicant's eligibility and it will not confer any right on him/her in anyway, at any stage of this selection process and also in any future selection in Vigilance deptt.

It is requested to give wide publicity to this notification, so that eligible candidates can benefit from this.

Concerned controlling Office/ Personnel branch should forward the eligible applications duly filled and completed in all respect, to Vigilance branch/Central Railway, so as to reach the same in the office of Vigilance Deptt. / Central Railway, HQR. office, CSMT, Mumbai-400001, positively on or before 12/02/2024 (Monday).

Applications received after this date will be summarily rejected.
