2.0 MAJOR HIGHLIGHTS

2.1 Loading:

Total originating loading of **36.85 million tons** was achieved upto Jan-25 against 40.17 million tons last year a drop of 8.3% (-3.32 MT). This year due to RCR ban from Apr-24 the coal loading from goods shed had shown a sharp decline(-1.65 MT) No loading of clinker from RGTM and less loading from CESG due to less demand (-0.51 MT) and drop in iron ore loading this year (-0.75MT)

2.2 Train operation

Interchange :

Freight interchange went up by 2.8% from 222.3 trains per day last year to 228.6 trains per day. The interchange in Jan-25 of 242.5 trains/day was second best.

Punctuality:

Despite rise in TOD and diverted trains and rise in interchange, due to extensive monitoring and punctuality drives the punctuality is above last year. 80.55% is achieved against 80.43% last year.

During the month of Nov, 10 pairs of delegate specials were effectively run for AISCSTEA's 2-day meeting at Nagpur without any adverse repercussion on regular freight and coaching traffic.

Improvement in granting of blocks :

Machine blocks improved by 3.8% from 10739 hrs. last year to 11145 in the current year.

Other Engg. blocks improved by 13.9% from 12043 hrs. last year to 13718 hrs. in the current year.

In OHE blocks the increase is 134% from 3716 last year to 8702 during the current year.

- NTKMs/Wagon day improved by 8.4% from 6737 NTKMs last year to 7300 NTKMs.
- Divisional wagon balance improved by 5.5% from 8666 units/day last year to 8189 units/day
- Wagon turn round improved by 6.9% from 1.69 wagon days last yea to 1.49 wagon days.
- Wagon kms per wagon day in used increased by 4.5% from 176 wagon kms/wagon day last year to 184 wagon kms/wagon day.

Commencement of issuance of caution order from COA-ICMS.

Real-time implementation of ICMS-COA caution order has commenced from 15th Jan. and caution orders are being issued from ICMS system for Nagpur-Badnera, Badnera-Nagpur, Amla-Chindwara, Narkher-Chandurbazar, Majri-Pimpalkuti and Tadali-Ghuggus sections.

Marg Darshak

Marg Darshak was installed at main entrance of Nagpur Railway station. Touch display kiosk is installed at the station to allow passengers to operate the Marg Darshak portal for easy navigation. Marg Darshak is a 3D/2D way-finder app for passenger amenities for Nagpur Station. Comprehensive assistance services like coolies, wheelchairs, medical assistance etc., can be accessed through a dedicated help desk system

• Riddhpur Halt station :

Riddhapur Halt station of religious importance was inaugurated in Sept., 24.

Sanjeevani Medical services:

Nagpur division has pioneered Telecom medicine in trains over Nagpur division by leveraging EMRs at NGP and BPQ Station to provide Quick diagnostic services to passengers in need. Average response time is 5 min in last 6 months

Pole Removal :

In June 2024, a pivotal role was played by all Sectional Commercial Inspectors along with their teams in the removal of unnecessary poles at 34 stations in the Nagpur Division. This effort has led to the clearance of obstacles to passenger movement, improved visibility of railway signages, and enhanced the aesthetics of railway stations. As a result, 410 unnecessary poles were removed from 34 stations in the division

100 % QR Code Payment Facility :

The QR code display facility has been provided at all 76 booking and reservation locations in the Nagpur division. Additionally, four parcel locations are equipped with QR code displays.
