

Unreserved Tickets On Mobile

- This facility has been inaugurated on 27th December 2014 by honourable minister for railway Shri Suresh Prabhu at Dadar station .Presently ,this facility has been extended to 72 stations on Mumbai Division of Central Railway.
- The said project is pilot project of Indian railway.

- **Steps to obtain UTS tickets on mobile are as follows:**
 - Passenger has to download UTS APP (search UTS) from play store and sign up.
 - Automatically R-wallet will be created with zero (0) balance.
 - Passenger has to go to any UTS counter of above mentioned stations to recharge his R- wallet.
 - Passengers can then book ticket and obtain SMS with booking ID (BID) number.
 - Passenger then has to go to journey, starting station and print his ticket by pressing “Prints Mobile Ticket “on ATVM.
 - Passenger then has to insert mobile number and BID number and press submit button on ATVM.
 - Ticket will be printed.
