No. 18 (2) of Annexure to rule 101 of IRCA Coaching Tariff No. 26, Part I (Vol. II) in the basic fares of Mail/Express trains in Second/Sleeper class to persons with earnings/emoluments of not more than ₹5000/- per month attending the All India Gandhian Constructive Workers Conference being organised jointly by Harijan Sevak Sangh, Delhi and Global Interfaith WASH Alliance & the Ganga Action Parivar, Parmarth Niketan, Rishikesh at Prayag Raj, Allahabad in January, 2019. (.) This concession has been granted as a very special case and should not be quoted as a precedent (.) This concession is admissible only in normal train services and not for booking of Special Trains/Coaches (.) The concessional return journey tickets may be issued on payment of one single journey Second/Sleeper class Mail/Express basic fares, (however, supplementary charges like reservation charge, superfast charge etc should be levied separately for both direction) to persons travelling more than 300 Kms. from journey commencing station to the station serving the place of conference i.e. Allahabad on production of the requisite certificate from the Organiser, Harijan Sevak Sangh, Kingsway Camp, Delhi (.) Necessary instructions may be issued to the staff concerned immediately (.) This issues with the concurrence of Finance Directorate of this Ministry (.) Matter most urgent (.) The procedure for availing of this concession is given in IRCA Coaching Tariff No. 26, Part I (Vol. II), a copy of which is available for reference at important Railway Stations and can also be purchased from the General Secretary, Indian Railway Conference Association, Chelmsford Road, New Delhi.
3. The certificate to the intending participants should be issued duly signed in ink and should bear the seal/stamp of the Association/Conference. They will not be accepted for the grant of concession if they bear the facsimile signature. A specimen of the Certificate is attached.
4. Certificates should not be issued to those whose travelling expenses are to be borne by the Central or State Government or a local body or statutory or a Corporation or a Government Undertaking or a University.
5. The certificate should not be issued to those persons whose earnings/ emoluments exceed ₹5,000/- per month.
6. The intending participants are required to submit the certificate to the authorised officer of the Railway concerned, namely the Principal Chief Commercial Manager, the Divisional Commercial Manager, etc. who will issue them the concession orders on presentation of which only the Station Master will allow concession to them.
7. Request for concession should be furnished at least two months in advance and the reference number and date of this letter must invariably be quoted in all future correspondence.
8. It may be noted that this concession has been granted as a very special case and should not be considered as a precedent for future. Since the concession has been granted for the dates and place decided by you, any request for change shall not be entertained. The General Manager or Principal Chief Commercial Manager of the concerned Zonal Railway may be approached for any complaint in regard to grant of concession.
