No TCIL/2066/11/Guru Ravi Das (.) Ministry of Railways have agreed to grant 50% concession appearing in S. No. 18 (2) of Annexure to rule 101 of IRCA Coaching Tariff No. 26, Part I (Vol. II) in basic fares of Mail/Express trains in Second/Sleeper class to persons with earnings/emoluments of not more than ₹5000/-per month travelling from Ambala, Jalandhar Bhatinda & Pune to Varanasi and back during 25.01.2020 to 20.02.2020 to attend the 643rd Birthday celebrations of Shri Guru Ravidass ji being organized by Shri Guru Ravidass Janam Asthan Public Charitable Trust, Jalandhar (.) This concession has been granted as a very special case and should not be quoted as a precedent (.) This concession is admissible only in normal train services and not for booking of Special Trains/Coaches (.) The concessional outward and return journey tickets may be issued, to not more than (1) 600 persons from Ambala, (2) 1700 persons from Jalandhar, (3) 600 persons from Bhatinda & (4) 300 persons from Pune, travelling more than 300 Kms. from the journey commencing station to the station serving the place of the Birthday celebrations, i.e. Varanasi on production of the requisite certificate from the Secretary of the above mentioned Organization (.) Necessary instructions may be issued to the staff concerned immediately (.) This issues with the concurrence of Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways (.) Matter most urgent (.) The procedure for availing of this concession is given in IRCA Coaching Tariff No. 26, Part I (Vol. II), a copy of which is available for reference at important Railway Stations and can be purchased from the General Secretary, Indian Railway Conference Association, Melinstord Road, New Delhi.

The certificate to the intending participants should be issued duly signed in ink and should bear the seal/stamp of the Association/Conference. They will not be accepted for the grant of concession if they bear the facsimile signature.

Certificates should not be issued to those whose travelling expenses are to be borne by the Central or State Government or a local body or statutory or a Corporation or a Government undertaking or a University.

The certificate should not be issued to those persons whose earnings/ emoluments exceed Rs. 1000/- per month.

The intending participants are required to submit the certificate to the authorised officer of the Railway concerned, namely the Principal Chief Commercial Manager, the Divisional Commercial Manager, etc. who will issue them the concession orders on presentation of which only the Station Master will allow concession to them.

It may be noted that this concession has been granted as a very special case and should not be considered as a precedent for future. Since the concession has been granted for the dates and place decided by you, any request for change shall not be entertained. The General Manager or Principal Chief Commercial Manager of the concerned Zonal Railway may be approached for any complaint in regard to grant of concession.
