

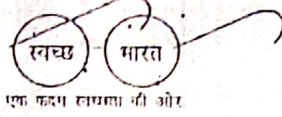
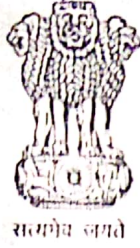

Your attention is invited towards a tragic incident of run over of 60 persons by a train No.74643 Jalandhar City-Amritsar DEMU between Mananawala-Amritsar on Jalandhar City-Amritsar Board gauge Double line electrified section at Km. 508/17-18 near level crossing No. S-27 in Firozpur Division of Northern Railway on 19.10.2018 at about 18.55 hours. The incident has been inquired into by the Chief Commissioner of Railway safety (CCRS), under the Ministry of Civil Aviation.

2. CCRS has classified the subject incident occurred in Amritsar on 19.10.2018 as Incident of Trespassing over the Railway property under Para 1.2.5 (Inspection and Inquiry) in his final Inquiry report. It has been concluded by the CCRS that the unfortunate incident of run over of 60 persons due to negligence of persons reportedly standing on and near railway track witnessing Dussehra Mela at Dhobi Ghat.

3. In CCRS's recommendation in Para 9.6 *"All Railway personnel connected with train operation, maintenance and patrolling activities should be cautioned to immediately communicate any such occurrence of persons in group walking along the track, if noticed by them, to the nearest station and necessary action like Caution Order should be given to all passing trains in accordance with G.R.4.09"*

4. Above recommendation of the CCRS has been accepted by the Board. Therefore, you are requested to take action on the recommendation mentioned above and submit compliance. Hon'ble MR has desired that all the recommendations need to be implemented within 90 days i.e. by 27.10.2020 positively.
