4) KALYAN SCHOOL

1. PRIMARY BUILDING RENOVATION:

Major renovation work of primary building is in progress. The following works have been completed.

- i. Flooring of all classrooms with Marbonite tiles.
- ii. Half wall tiling with marbonite tiles in 08 classrooms, 4 classes remaining
- iii. Painting of primary building with good quality VOC paints, including classrooms.
- iv. Steel fabrication to fortify ceilings of 08 ground floor classrooms.
- v. Replacement of old cement asbestos roof sheets with PPGI roof sheets.
- vi. “Rain Water Harvesting Project” for IGBC certification.
- vii. Old fans replaced with power saving fans in all classrooms.
- viii. Old tube lights replaced with power saving LED tube lights.
- ix. Construction of new school gate with granite embossment towards KG end.
- x. Installed garden & rod LED lights with ‘migrant bird compliance’ in playground.
- xi. Painting of outside science building and labs, exterior of building was painted by students with sports motifs.
- xii. Installation of air conditioner in Health and Fitness room.
- xiii. Gate No 41 side main school wall was constructed and painted with messages of National Integration.

OTHER ACHIEVEMENTS

- 1) Team of students along with teachers painted an entire EMU Rake in Tri-color for inaugural run on 2nd October 2018 for “Swacch Bharat Mission”. The entire Rake had messages related to this Abhiyaan.
- 2) Students performed extremely well in the CBSE cluster meet held in Kolhapur. Our school stood 2nd among 180 participating schools. We bagged 19 medals. Miss Sneha Khushwaha of STD IX was awarded with championship trophy. 8 students qualified for Nationals.
