SALIENT FEATURES

- **Solapur** is one of the Division of Central Railway situated on Mumbai-Chennai route having 1011.40 route kilometers.
- **Jurisdiction:** Manmad - Daund, Daund -Wadi, Kurduwadi –Latur Road & Kurduwadi- Miraj. This division plays the pivotal role of being corridor connection to West and South.
- **Civil Districts Headquarters:** The Division covers 7 civil districts of Maharashtra State viz. Nasik, Ahmednagar, Pune, Solapur, Sangli, Latur, Osmanabad & one district of Karnataka i.e. Kalaburagi.
- The Division has **86 stations** in its jurisdiction under various categories.
- An annual average of **3.04 crores originating passengers** was dealt on Solapur Division in financial year 2019-20. An annual originating **Revenue of Rs. 826.28 crores** generated by Solapur Division in financial year 2019-20.
- **Route length (Kms) :** S/L – 688.24, Kms , D/L – 323.445 Kms= **Total- 1011.685 Kms**
- **States in Solapur Division territory:** Maharashtra: 89.76%, Karnataka: 10.24 %,

TICKETING SYSTEM:

- **UTS:** - Unreserved Ticketing System is provided at all 77 stations which are manned by either Commercial or operating staff on the division. At halt stations which are operated by halt station contractors the conventional printed card tickets & UTS ticket are issued.
- **UTS cum PRS:** - Unreserved Ticketing systems Cum Passenger Reservation System are operated at 23 locations.
- **PRS:** - Computerized Passenger Reservation System at 16 PRS locations out of which 10 are Railway operated PRS centres and balance 6 locations are Non-Rail Head locations.
- **JTBS:** - 5 Jansadharan Ticket Booking Sevaks are available at 4 locations.
- **YTSK:** 7 Yatri Ticket Suvidha Kendra are appointed at Solapur and 2 at Kalaburagi station.
- **ATVM :-** Automatic Ticket Vending Machines– 18,
- **Co-TVM:** -Coin & currency operated Ticket Vending Machine - 12.
- **STBA:** -Station Ticket Booking Agents have been nominated at 21 - NSG6 category stations.

AIMING TO CUSTOMER'S SATISFACTION:

- **PC based PA system** provided at 17 stations. & 4 Manual PA systems is provided at 4 stations.
- **Coach Guidance System:** provided at 10 Stations i.e Wadi, Kalaburagi, Solapur, Kurduwadi, Daund, Ahmednagar, Belapur, Kopergaon, Sainagar Shirdi & Latur.
- **Train indication board** are provided at 17 stations
- **CCTV:** Provided at 6 Stations i.e. Kalaburagi, Solapur, Kurduwadi, Daund, Kopergaon & Sainagar Shirdi.
- **Wi-Fi:** provided at 77 Stations

OTHER ACTIVITIES:

- **Cleanliness Activities:** To expedite with effective cleanliness activities mechanized cleaning contracts have been awarded at 9 major stations. Rests all stations, Station Managers are provided with imprest to carry out this activity wherever neither contract is awarded nor staff is posted.
- **Pay and Use contracts:** For better maintenance of Urinals/Toilets at stations Pay and Use contracts are awarded at 9 stations. Pay and Use Toilets in the circulating area are also provided at Wadi, and Ahmednagar.
- **Deluxe Toilet** provided at circulating area of Sainagar Shirdi & Solapur.
- **Parking Facilities:** Two wheeler/four wheeler parking facilities are provided at major stations & premium parking facility is also provided at Solapur.
- **Caterings Units:** Inspection of Tea stall, refreshment room at stations and pantry car of trains are carried out frequently by Commercial Officers & Supervisors to check the quantity, quality & use of standard approved raw material. Samples are also collected by Medical department to check the quality and adulteration if any.
- **Public Grievances:** The Public Grievances cell has been made operative in Commercial Control, Solapur round the clock. The complaints received on twitter, SMS, COMS, CPGRAM are redressed on real time basis.
- **Toll Free Customer helpline number 139:** The helpline will address complaints relating to cleanliness, food and catering, coach maintenance, medical emergency, & linen.
